EXHIBITIONS IN BIBIANA

LAND OF THE COMICS

Plavčík and Vratko – a funny horror for children

Exhibition visitors can enter the black and white world of the comics in which fairy tale characters will be their guides and give tips on how to do good deeds and liberating acts in the world where anything that has been drawn is possible. The Land of Comics is introduced as a kind of graphic art drawing from a generally-known Slovak folk tale Plavčík and Vratko. The exhibition has been designed as an interactive journey that includes humor and horror during which the children, having completed various assignments, can break the spell over three towns. The journey takes everyone through a "valley of tears" to a pear tree with a snake suffocating its roots, to a well that has been taken over by a frog, and then to the golden hair of Vratko.
