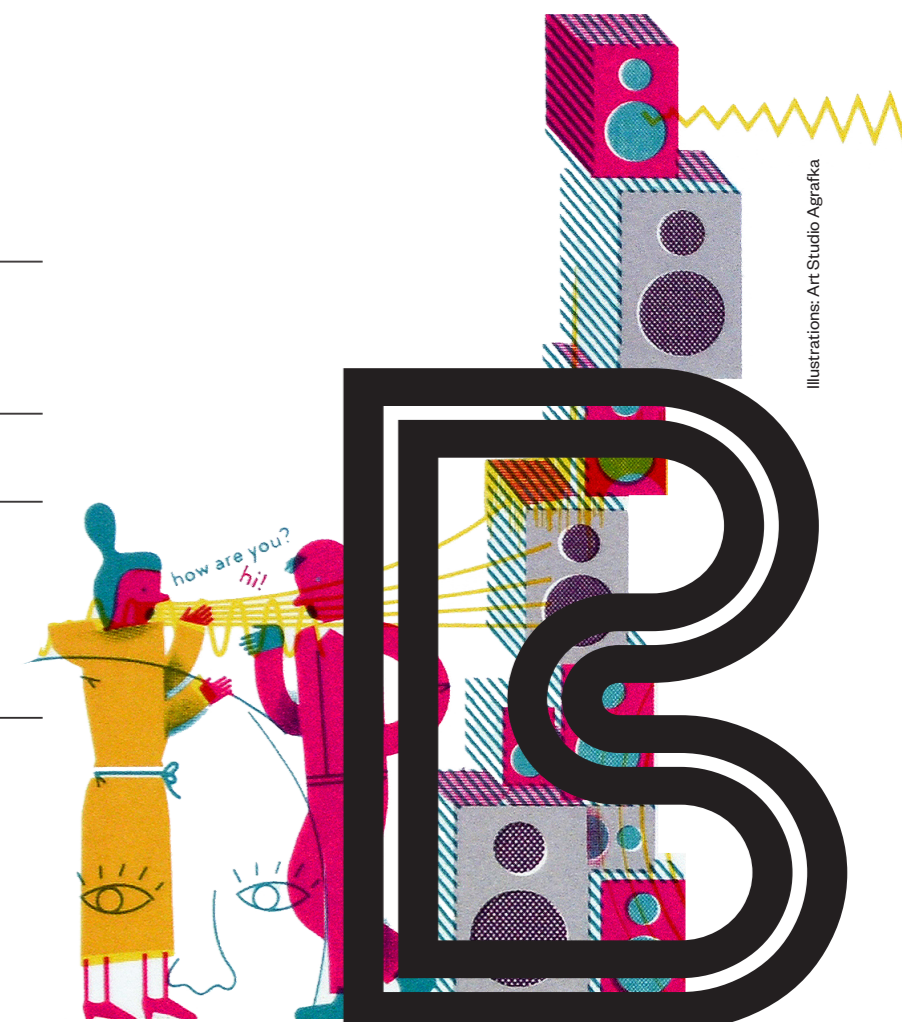

## BIB 2023

The international competitive exhibition of original illustrations of children's books the Biennial of Illustrations Bratislava (BIB) is one of the most important events held under the auspices of UNESCO and The International Board on Books for Young People (IBBY), with the support of the Ministry of Culture of the Slovak Republic. The main organizer is BIBIANA, International House of Art for Children. At the the Biennial of Illustrations Bratislava, which is a key event of fine art and illustration for children of world importance, the best illustrators meet every odd-numbered year in the fall since the 1967. This year 275 illustrators from 36 countries compete with 2072 illustrations from 355 books, and hundreds more non-competitive artworks will be on display at 10 accompanying exhibitions around the city. We sincerely thank all our partners and participants.

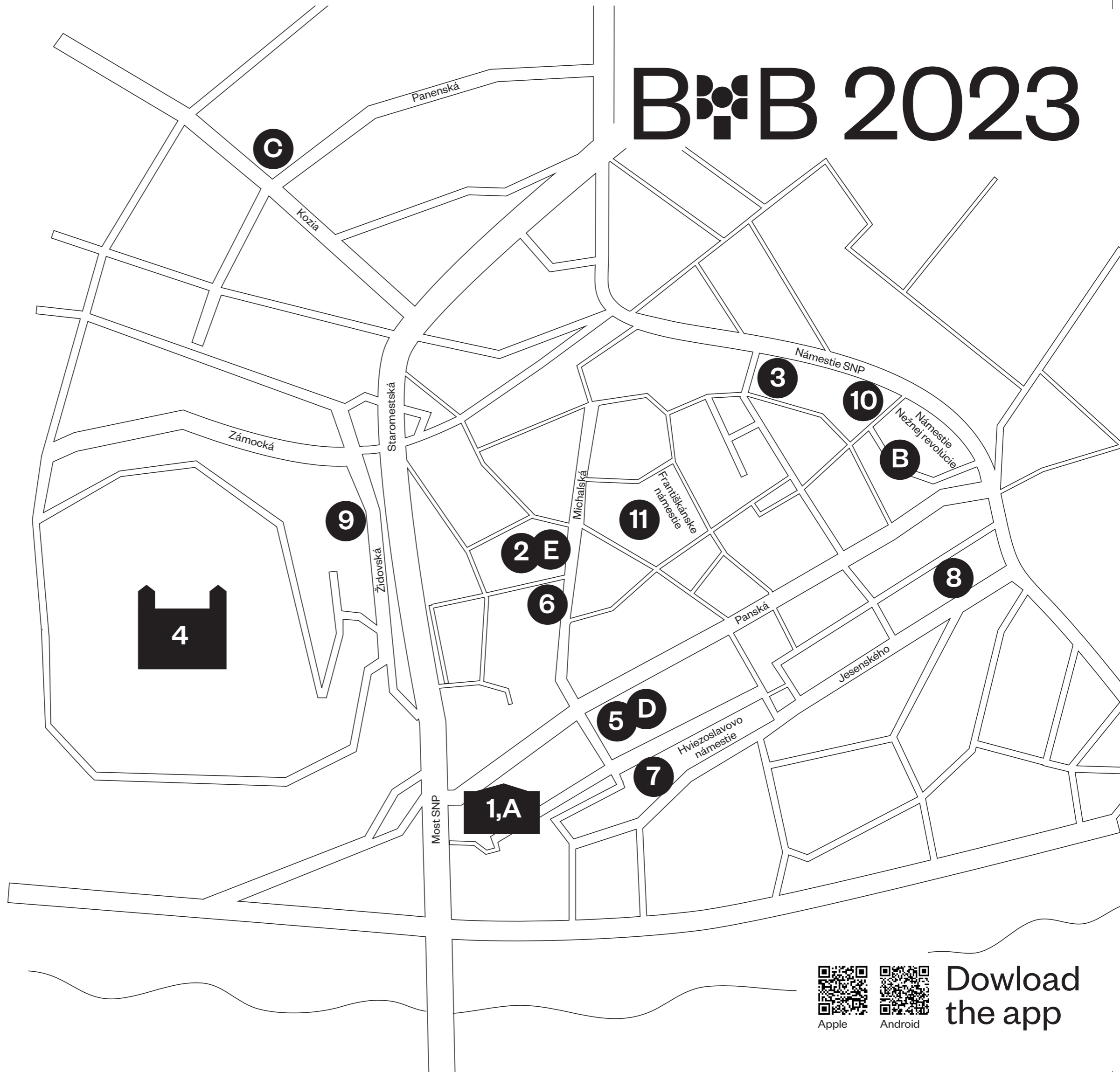
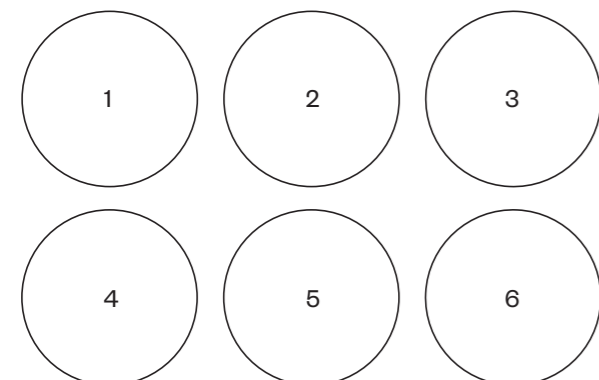
