BIENNALE OF ILLUSTRATIONS BRATISLAVA 2021 (October 15, 2021 – January 9, 2022)

Castle of Bratislava, 2nd floor

The autumnal Bratislava gets animated again with illustrations of children's books and for the 20th times already it will be a show of the best from the world of such kind of illustration over the recent two years.

The international competitive show of original book-illustrations for children Biennale of illustrations Bratislava will be held from 15/10/2021 to 9/1/2022 at the premises of the Castle of Bratislava. The event's major organiser is BIBIANA, International House of Art for Children — under the auspices of UNESCO and the International Board on Books for Young People (IBBY) and kindly supported by the Slovak Ministry of Culture. For this year's Biennale, almost 380 illustrators from 42 countries got registered — sending in more than 2 700 individual illustrations and almost 500 books.

This unique event comprises also workshops, discussions with the artistic creators, illustrators and various other activities for the kids. The visitors may even browse the competition-titles in the reference library.

12/10/ Topic: "A journey to the big, big world. (The importance of picture-book in a technology-influenced world)"

The reading of illustrations and the reading of picture books have a significant stimulating function for the child, becoming a starting point for its own reflections, thoughts and self-expression. In the world of prevailing technologies — the significance for conveying a message from the picture book becomes even more important.

13/10/ Topic: "A printed book as a stabilising element for a child (Reading a real (physical) book as a stimulating and supportive process)"

Reading has a stabilising function for the child. How can a book become a means of stabilisation? And why is it so important to read a real (physical, paper-made) book? What and how does a book stimulate in children - which they can ("physically" again) hold in their hands? What can it be helpful in?

EXHIBITIONS AT BIBIANA

FROM ONE TOY TO ANOTHER

A well designed and manufactured toy supports and even develops the sense of beauty, purposefulness and empathy in us. Our exhibition starts with a re-paint of a painting by Pieter Brueghel, on which the kids can look for games that are sill played today. Further they find here replicas of historic toys made according to archaeological findings, the iconic technical construction toy "Merkur" (screws and perforated sheet-metal parts), which gets manufactured since 1920 a city from a big and colourful kit, a tiny house for the dolls and a Teddy-bear, but also plastic-toys from the last century by the famous designer Libuša Niklová. They will learn to know toys designed by our contemporary designers and they can even invent and design their very own toy.

This interactive toy-focused exhibition is BIBIANA's contribution to the Year of Slovak Design, which was proclaimed by the Culture Ministry of the Slovak Republic.

SILENT VOYAGE

This is a playful and inspirational exhibition offering a voyage through the world of "silent" books from all over the world (European, American, Arabic, Japanese, Korean as well as Australian ones). Silent books consisting just of pictures without any text currently — do represent just a little-known genre of children literature. The juvenile visitor gets a unique opportunity for looking, discovering and getting-to-know the stories hidden in the pics.

A total of 130 titles from all over the world, from folding-picture-books through normal picture books and graphical novels — present a wide spectrum of remarkable books from different genres by really exceptional international illustrators. Using various activities (a travel log, story-blocks, "touch"-game, shadow-play-theatre, puzzle and folders...) —

it initiates social games, as well as talks and experience-learning for individuals, families and collectives at the Dušan Roll Gallery (Galéria Dušana Rolla).
